On the following evening, May the 8th at 6 pm, LSS will host a Grade 7 parent meeting. All parents and guardians are invited to come to the multipurpose room to hear about our Grade 8 program.

Approximate School Fees and Supplies needed:

At high school, basic materials and texts are supplied by the school. The school act requires that parents provide basic supplies and Physical Education strip.

The following is an outline of what students need and other instances in which a student could be asked for money:

Student Activity Fees: \$25

Student fees are charged to all registered students of LSS. The funds collected are administered through Student Council. Fees assist in 'off setting' the cost of initiatives such as; school activities, special speakers and projects, student leadership ventures. All fees are due by September 27th.

Locks

The school provides lockers for student use. Students **must** purchase a school lock. Locks are sold to students for approximately \$6.00. They may also wish to purchase one if a gym locker is available.

P.E. Strip

Students in grade 8 all take PE. They may have PE in the first semester or the second semester. They will need shorts, a t-shirt, runners and socks.

Basic School Supplies

Students should have the following: loose leaf paper, pens, pencils, ruler, erasers, pencil crayons, binders (depending on teachers), and a calculator.

School Photos

All students are asked to have their picture taken for safety reasons. There is no fee for the basic photo. Students get a student card and their picture goes into the Year Book. Additional photo packages can be ordered at a fee.

Year Book

The Year Book is an optional purchase for students. Sales may begin in September and continue until near the end of the school year. Cost is approximately \$55.

Field Trips

A class may decide to go on a field trip which may require a fee to cover admission, transportation, etc. Parents receive this information in advance and participation is optional. Alternate arrangements will be made at the school for any students who are not attending the field trip.

Athletic Fees

Students who participate on school teams will be charged a uniform deposit and an athletic fee, which varies by sport.
