GT Learning Outcomes



It is expected that students:

- demonstrate the **confidence** and **competency** needed to be self-directed individuals, by:
 1. **Developing a comprehensive plan that indicates they are prepared to successfully transition from secondary school**
 2. **Presenting selected components of the transition plan to members of the school and/or community**

Developing a comprehensive plan that indicates they are prepared to successfully transition from secondary school, which includes...

- a. Completion of transition activities that are relevant to and support their career, life, and learning goals.**
- b. Identification and communication of achievements that reflect the development of the attributes of a BC graduate.**
- c. Identification and communication of costs and funding sources associated with education, career, and life options after graduation.**

During your Exit Interview, you will:

1. Demonstrate and practice
communication, organizational
and presentation skills

1. Share your transition plan and
short- and long-term goals



3. Demonstrate how you **display initiative, set priorities, and establish goals** through selected achievements in which you take pride



4. Showcase significant accomplishments in your education through 2 artifacts

5. Indicate how your **learning experiences prepare you for successful transitions to life after secondary school**
